A World of Discovery

AHI Connects | *Calvados Tasting.* Normandy's famous apple cider brandy is among the world's finest brandies. Visit an estate that distills Calvados and learn about the production process. Relish a traditional Norman lunch with a glass of Calvados.

Discover Honfleur. Take a guided walk to discover this captivating French port town. Soak up the charming maritime ambience of the 17th-century Vieux Bassin, where the Seine River meets the English Channel. As you stroll narrow, cobblestone streets, see the wooden Church of Sainte-Cathérine, crafted by 15th-century shipbuilders.

D-Day and the Battle of Normandy. Take an emotional journey to sites pivotal to Allied success. Visit the Landing Museum in Arromanches and enjoy lunch at a local restaurant. Continue along the Calvados coastline, which provided the theater for Operation Overlord. Visit the Omaha Beach Memorial and the solemn Normandy American Cemetery at Colleville-sur-Mer. Then, travel to the German defensive emplacement at Point du Hoc, where U.S. Rangers scaled 100-foot cliffs to destroy German enemy artillery emplacements.

Château du Bec. Cross the famous Pont de Normandie bridge over the Seine River en route to Le Havre. Visit Château du Bec, a beautiful, privately owned, 10th-century castle. Meet one of the owners and walk through the lovely grounds. Relish a lunch of local cuisine amid the idyllic setting.

Le Havre. Visit this reconstructed, major French port city on the English Channel to appreciate it as an outstanding post-war example of urban planning and architecture.

Musée Malraux of Modern Art (MuMa). Relish a guided tour of MuMa, which holds one of the most important collections of impressionist paintings in France, including works by Degas, Monet and Renoir.

Mont-Saint-Michel. Delight in a visit to the marvelous tidal island of Mont-Saint-Michel. Take a guided walk to visit the 8th-century Benedictine church and monastery. Enjoy free time to stroll and shop along the lovely Grand Rue or wander the ramparts.

Bayeux. Travel to the scenic, medieval town of Bayeux for a visit and guided tour of the 11th-century Notre-Dame Cathedral, a masterpiece of Norman Gothic architecture.

Le Mémorial de Caen. Tour this significant museum and war memorial. Dedicated to peace and 20th-century history, it focuses on World War II and the Cold War. You'll gain insight through poignant and powerful photos, films and personal stories, and explore artifacts and interactive exhibits.

Honfleur. Craft your own itinerary during a full day at leisure in this picturesque coastal town, immortalized in paintings by Claude Monet. Stroll among the vendors on market days, situated around the great wooden Church of St. Catherine, wander its medieval cobblestone streets and admire timbered houses along the historic harbor.
