

Day 1| In Transit

Depart your gateway city for Brussels, Belgium.

Day 2 | Brussels, Belgium | Antwerp

Upon arrival, transfer **3** to the ship in Antwerp.

Antwerp Walking Tour. Located on the Scheldt River, Antwerp has long been a prominent center of trade. On a guided walk, appreciate its bounty of medieval architecture. See the Gothic Cathedral of Our Lady, the 16th-century town hall and Grote Markt square lined with narrow guild halls.

Enrichment: Contemporary Belgium.

The ship moors overnight in Antwerp.

Day 3 | Bruges | Veere, Netherlands

This morning, enjoy a scenic drive to Bruges.

PYJ | Choose one of these excursions:

All excursions include a guided walk in Bruges' old town. See the Basilica of the Holy Blood, the medieval guild hall buildings and the Belfry Tower. Afterward, begin your selected tour.

- *Cultural Bruges.* Study fascinating artwork from the Flemish primitive and expressionist periods at the Groeninge Museum. (*Active*)
- *Bruges & Beer.* Delve into Belgian brewing traditions at the family-owned De Halve Maan Brewery. Sample their beer and enjoy the city views from the rooftop. (*Active*)
- Bruges & Belgian Chocolate. Cocoa beans were first introduced in Belgium in the 17th century. At a chocolatier's shop, learn what makes Belgian chocolate special and indulge in some sweet samples. (Active)

Make your own lunch plans in Bruges, then rejoin the group to meet the ship in Middelburg. While the ship cruises to Veere tonight, gather for a Welcome Reception and Dinner.

Day 4 | Veere

Free Time: Join the half-day Elective Activity or explore on your own in Veere for the day.

(Figure 1) Reeltje Jans & Delta Expo. Travel along the Zeeland coast to the artificial island of Neeltje Jans. Learn about the Delta Works, the massive dams and storm surge barriers that protect the third of Netherlands' landmass below sea level. Then, experience the impact of the devastating 1953 North Sea flood in a gripping, 4D panoramic animation. The ship moors overnight in Willemstad.

Day 5 | The Hague • Delft • Gouda

Enrichment: The Dutch Masters.

PIJ | Choose one of these excursions:

• The Hague & the Mauritshuis. See top sites including the Binnenhof, the center of Dutch





politics, and the Peace Palace, on a scenic tour. Next, view the remarkable paintings and sculptures of the famed Mauritshuis, which houses Vermeer's "Girl with a Pearl Earring."

- Old Delft & the Porcelain Factory. Take a guided stroll in Delft's old town, then tour the Royal Delft Porcelain Factory, founded in 1653. Watch a master artisan hand-paint the famous blue-and-white pottery and view a fine collection of antique Delft earthenware.
- Gouda City of Cheese. See the bustling market square and the 15th-century town hall before admiring the exquisite, 16th-century painted-glass windows inside Sint Janskerk. Finish with a tasting of fresh Gouda cheeses. After lunch on board, cruise this afternoon



toward Enkhuizen on the banks of the IJssel.

Day 6 | Enkhuizen • Hoorn

Arrive today in Enkhuizen, filled with impressive architecture from the 16th and 17th centuries.

PYJ | Choose one of these excursions:

- Enkhuizen Walking Tour & Zuiderzee Museum. See Enkhuizen's stately landmarks from the Dutch Golden Age, and learn about daily life by the sea at Zuiderzee's recreated village of more than 140 historic buildings.
- *Historic Hoorn Walking Tour.* Hoorn was a major Dutch East India Company port in the 17th century. In its heyday, ships returned here from around the world with valuable cargo such as pepper, nutmeg and cloves. Relish its lovely highlights on a stroll.
- West Frisian Bicycle Tour. Ride through the breathtaking countryside near Enkhuizen, and pedal past little villages, churches and the pastoral dikes of the IJssel, the largest man-made lake in the Netherlands. (Active)





Enjoy lunch on board the ship.

Free Time: Explore Enkhuizen on your own. The ship cruises to Amsterdam late this evening and docks overnight.

Day 7 | Amsterdam

Enrichment: Contemporary Netherlands.

Canals of Amsterdam. Get a delightful perspective of this captivating city on a guided cruise along its vibrant, leafy canals.

Savor lunch aboard the ship.

Free Time: Create your own plans in the city.

Day 8 | Amsterdam

Keukenhof Gardens. Revel in the enchanting beauty of this 80-acre garden overflowing with tulips, hyacinths, daffodils and other blooms. Return to the ship for lunch.

Free Time: Spend the afternoon at leisure. Tonight, share in a festive Farewell Reception and Dinner to commemorate your journey.


