In Cusco, dive into history with the sacred Koricancha temple and the artistic San Blas neighborhood. Hike through the Sacred Valley to Ollantaytambo's Inca fortress, then discover the surreal Moray terraces and Maras salt pans. Trek the Short Inca Trail to Machu Picchu, soak in epic views from Inti Punku, and wander through ancient ruins. Thrill-seekers conquer Rainbow Mountain's stunning colors and capture breathtaking Andean vistas. Adventure, culture, and unforgettable moments await.

DAY 3 LIMA

Whether you are wandering through the colorful streets of Barranco, savoring world-renowned Peruvian street food, or taking in the coastal ocean views, Lima has something for everyone. This buzzing city is a dynamic mix of old and new—where pre-Incan ruins stand beside trendy coffee shops and cutting-edge art galleries. With its incredible food scene, picture-perfect spots, and endless adventures, Lima is the perfect starting point for your Peruvian journey. After breakfast, we immerse ourselves in the vibrant atmosphere of the Surquillo Market, where the textures, colors, and aromas of local life come alive. This bustling market offers a true taste of Lima's daily rhythm and a chance to connect with its people. Continue via Plaza Mayor and the cathedral of Lima to one of the oldest Chinatowns in the Americas, Calle Capón—an energetic enclave showcasing the rich Chinese influence on the city. The afternoon is yours to continue exploring iconic sights like the Larco Museum, known for its fascinating pre-Columbian art, or the Barranco district's street art scene. We'll end the day with a dinner of delicious Peruvian specialties at a local restaurant.

DAY 4 LIMA – CUSCO (DAY 2 of base land package)

This morning, transfer to Lima's airport to continue your journey to Cusco.

PERU'S INCA TRAIL MAIN TOUR

DAY 1 FLIGHT TO PERU

Board your overnight flight to Cusco today.

Meals: In-flight

DAY 2 CUSCO

Upon arrival at Cusco airport, transfer to your group hotel. Enjoy the remainder of the morning at leisure to explore the city. Start adjusting to the altitude in preparation for our trek, join our local English-speaking expert on a tour of the impressive Imperial City of Cusco, an example of the harmonious coexistence of the Andean and Spanish cultures. We tour the Koricancha, an ancient sacred space the Incas dedicated to the worship of the sun and the moon. We continue to the Main Square with the imposing Cathedral, and the magnificent Jesuit church. The city's colonial buildings compose the most beautiful and captivating sceneries in Peru. We finish our tour with a visit to the bohemian neighborhood of San Blas, known as 'the artists' district,' with narrow winding streets lined with popular arts and craft shops. In the evening, join us for a welcome orientation and dinner with fellow young alumni travelers while being entertained by local dance performances.

DAY 3 CUSCO – SACRED VALLEY OF THE INCAS – OLLANTAYTAMBO

This morning we board our private motor coach and start our journey to the Sacred Valley. Our destination, Ollantaytambo, is a small town built around an impressive Incan fortress and soaring peaks of the Andes. For an amazing view and a closer look, we climb up over two hundred steps to admire the astonishing monoliths that make up the Temple of the Sun. This was the site of a rare Inca victory over the Spanish in 1538, led by Manco Inca. After some free time to visit the town and market, we continue to our hotel for the overnight stay in the Sacred Valley.

Duration of excursion: approx. 4 hours

Elevation: 9,160 ft

DAY 4 SACRED VALLEY – MARAS – MORAY – PICHINGOTO

Today we explore the "Sacred Valley of the Incas." We first reach the Moray archaeological site, where giant Incan circular and semi-circular agricultural terraces were constructed to be used as a botanical laboratory. Here they experimented on plant domestication and foreign crop acclimatization in the fascinating cloud forest eco system. In Maras, we hike down to the largest salt pans in the region, which have been mined continuously since the Incan Empire. Leaving Maras, we arrive at the village of Pichingoto, the top salt producer during the Spanish colonial era. We return to our hotel through the Sacred Valley, lined with corn fields and green prairies.

DAY 5 SACRED VALLEY – SHORT INCA TRAIL BY EXPEDITION TRAIN – MACHU PICCHU – AGUAS CALIENTES

We check out of our hotel this morning and board our private motor coach to the Ollantaytambo train station. The expedition train will take us on a scenic journey to KM 104 where we join the Camino Inca. From here we start our trek to the Chachabamba site, then ascend to a striking waterfall. After an upwards climb, we arrive at the Incas site Wiñay Wayna called "Forever Young," an impressive complex made up of an agricultural center with terraces, a religious sector and an urban sector. After a box lunch we will then continue for about one hour further onto "Inti Punku" – "The Sun Gate" with an amazing view of Machu Picchu. Return to Aguas Calientes by motor coach and enjoy free time to explore the hermosmedicinal hot springs.

DAY 6 AGUAS CALIENTES – MACHU PICCHU – CUSCO

This morning, after a short bus ride, we will hike up to the Machu Picchu ruins, a national sanctuary, UNESCO World Cultural Heritage site, and one of the New 7 Wonders of the World. Our local expert shows us the breathtaking and mysterious ruins as we climb to the top of Mount Huayna Picchu, Quechua for "Young Mountain," on the eastern side of the Central Cordillera. This peak shelters another archaeological site, the Temple of the Moon, which is connected to Machu Picchu. We return to Aguas Calientes for a lunch of Peruvian fare before boarding our train back to Ollantaytambo. Our final destination today is Cusco, where we check-in to our hotel for our last overnight. Share impressions of the last days with fellow explorers during our farewell dinner of local specialties.

PERU'S INCA TRAIL POST TOUR

Stay an extra day and explore the breathtaking Rainbow, where vibrant hues of red, turquoise, and gold create a surreal, multicolored landscape. Standing at an impressive altitude of 16,498 feet, these natural wonders offer a stunning panoramic view that's both awe-inspiring and Instagram-worthy. The challenging trek to reach them adds to the adventure, making the journey to see these incredible mountains a truly unforgettable experience.

DAY 1 (Day 7 on base itinerary) – CUSCO

Rise and shine early for an unforgettable adventure. Your day begins with a scenic 3-hour drive to the trailhead, passing through the charming village of Cuspata. Along the way, be enchanted by herds of alpacas and llamas, and catch a glimpse of the majestic Ausangate Mountain—an incredible opportunity for those perfect snapshots. Upon arrival, we'll begin a 1.5-hour hike to the breathtaking Vinicunca, the famous Rainbow Mountain, towering at 16,498 feet. As you reach the iconic red hill, you will be greeted by the vibrant, natural colors of turquoise, orange, red, and brown sedimentary rock that paint this mesmerizing landscape. It is a view like no other, where the layers of colorful rock unfold into a surreal Andean dream. At the summit, take a well-deserved break to soak in the panoramic views and capture the moment. After reveling in the beauty of this natural wonder, we begin our descent, with the Andean vistas accompanying us along the way. Enjoy a hearty lunch before heading back to Cusco on a relaxing 2-hour drive. In total, this epic journey covers 4 miles (about 3 hours) of hiking and around 10 hours in total, combining driving and trekking. After a full day of adventure, rest up and reflect on the awe-inspiring experience with plenty of photos to post to keep everyone at home feeling just a little bit jealous.
