

**Day 1 | August 6**

Depart your home city for an overnight flight to Reykjavík, Iceland.

Day 2 | August 7 **B**

Reykjavík, Iceland

Arrive in Reykjavík, a modern city rich with culture and natural beauty. Check in to the Iceland Parliament Hotel.

After lunch at leisure, join the group for an insightful Reykjavík city tour. Witness Laugardalur Park and the impressive Hallgrímskirkja church. Visit the Perlan Museum to enjoy views from the observation deck.

Explore Reykjavík during dinner on your own tonight.

Day 3 | August 8 **B-D**

Reykjavík | Embark Ship

After breakfast, spend free time discovering the city at your own pace. Later, embark the deluxe *World Voyager*.

Day 4 | August 9 **B-L-R-D**

Cruise the Denmark Strait | Arctic Circle

Savor breakfast on board and spend the day cruising the Denmark Strait. Also known as the Greenland Strait, this navigational passage sits between Greenland and Iceland in the Arctic Circle, connecting the Greenland and Irminger sea waters.

Attend tonight's Captain's Welcome Reception.

Day 5 | August 10 **B-L-D**

Ittoqqortoormiit, Greenland
After breakfast, disembark in Ittoqqortoormiit, a remote Greenland village located

approximately 400 miles above the Arctic Circle on the rugged shores of the Scoresby Sound fjord. It is a destination of supreme beauty and home to one of the world's last remaining hunter societies.

Day 6 | August 11 **B-L-D**

Scoresby Sound

Arrive in Scoresby Sound, the world's longest and largest fjord system with a maze of inlets, sparkling blue icebergs, alabaster glaciers and endless ice. Watch for barnacle geese, northern wheatears, black-legged kittiwakes and more while Zodiac cruising

through this wonderland. Soak up the solitude and glorious nature around you. After lunch on the ship, enjoy more cruising in Scoresby Sound.

Later, gather with friends for dinner. Share your day's experiences and your hopes for tomorrow's solar eclipse.

Day 7 | August 12 B-L-D

Day at Sea | Solar Eclipse Viewing

While sailing back to Iceland, we will be in the direct path of the solar eclipse, cruising in the narrow path of totality. The point of maximum eclipse is located just outside Breiðafjörður Bay, between the tips of the Westfjords and

the Snæfellsnes Peninsula. Weather permitting, enjoy this rare and unforgettable opportunity. Watch as the sky darkens as the moon completely covers the sun, revealing the sun's corona, the star's outer atmosphere.

Day 8 | August 13 B-L-D

Ísafjörður, Iceland | Ósvör | Vigur Island

Get to know the astonishing and dramatic Westfjords, a wild, rock-strewn landscape of soaring mountains, winding roads and tiny villages. Learn about traditional seafaring life at the shore-side settlement of Ósvör, a replica of a 19th-century fishing station. Continue to friendly

Bolungarvík, perched on the edge of the region's largest fjord, and see the Buna River and a waterfall in Tunguskogur. Return to Ísafjörður and notice the town's many timber-framed houses. Back on board, enjoy lunch and sail to Vigur Island, an Icelandic haven.

At Vigur Island, join your guide for an informative stroll around the tiny, spear-shaped island, a sanctuary to abundant birdlife, including eider ducks, puffins, Arctic terns, black guillemots and other species. Island residents collect the soft down from eider duck nests to wash and use in bedding, coats and cushions. The island is also

home to seals and other wildlife. Enjoy a sense of timelessness while passing by relics, such as Iceland's only wooden windmill, built in 1840, and the boat "Vigur Breiður," which is still used for fishing and ferrying goods and sheep.

Day 9 | August 14 B-L-R-D

Grundarfjörður |
Snæfellsnes Peninsula

Be immersed in awe-inspiring landscapes while exploring the enigmatic Snæfellsnes Peninsula. Begin in lovely

Grundarfjörður, one of Iceland's oldest settlements. Gaze at the striking Kirkjufell Mountain, the country's most photographed mountain. Travel to Djúpalónssandur, where scattered remains of a 1948 shipwreck lie along the black sand. The beach is also home to huge boulders that the Vikings used to test their strength in the days of the fishing stations.

Continue to Malarrif to see its towering white lighthouse before visiting the little fishing community of Arnarstapi,

where thousands of nesting birds make their homes in the sea caves cliffs. In Budir, see Búðakirkja, a famous black church that is a significant landmark of the region.

Return to the ship for a Captain's Farewell Reception.

Day 10 | August 15 B

Reykjavík | Disembark Ship |
Return to Home City

Arrive in Reykjavík and transfer to the airport for your flight back to your home city.
