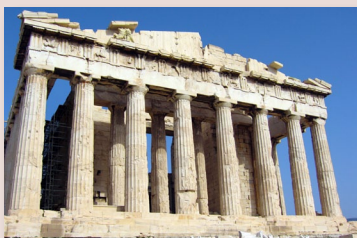
Nafplia

DAY 1&2 ARRIVE ATHENS, NAFPLIO



Arrive Athens, transfer to our seaside hotel in historic Nafplio, and enjoy the panoramic sea views from your room. After a welcome reception, gather together for dinner out on one of Nafplio's charming streets at a family-run taverna. (R,D)

DAY 3 NAFPLIO, THEATER OF EPIDAVROS

After a cultural orientation to life in Greece, explore picturesque Nafplio and peruse the local produce at its streetside farmers' market. Continue to ancient Epidavros and marvel at its magnificent theater, the best preserved from ancient Greece. In the evening, enjoy a festive dinner waterside accompanied by local musicians. (B,L,D)



DAY 8 ATHENS, ACROPOLIS MUSEUM

Depart Hydra by high-speed ferry and check-in to our hotel at the foot of Athens' Acropolis before visiting the Acropolis Museum with its legendary Parthenon Marbles. In the evening, enjoy the unforgettable views of the Parthenon from our hotel's roof garden. (B,D)

DAY 9 ATHENS WALKING TOUR

Today, visit the world-changing sites of Athens, including the Theater of Dionysus, the birthplace of drama and comedy. Ascend the Acropolis to marvel at the stunning Parthenon as we discuss Greek democracy. At the Areopagus, hear the words of the Apostle Paul in their original context. Then, enjoy lunch and free time in the traditional Plaka marketplace district. (B,L)

DAY 10 ATHENS, CAPE SOUNION

After a free morning, visit the National Archaeological Museum, home to the world's greatest collection of Greek antiquities. Then, enjoy a festive final dinner at a seaside taverna before marveling at the stunning sunset over the Aegean Sea from the unforgettable promontory of the Temple of Poseidon at Cape Sounion. (B,D)

Depart Athens renewed, inspired, and wiser. Or, join the extension to the stunningly beautiful island of Santorini. (B)



DAY 4 MYCENAE, NEMEA, VINEYARD TOUR

Visit the bronze-age palace citadel of ancient Mycenae, home to King Agamemnon of the Trojan War, and stand inside the Temple of Zeus in ancient Nemea. Then, continue to a countryside, family-run vineyard for a wine tasting and a sumptuous feast. In the evening, watch the sunset over the Aegean Sea from the panoramic vistas of Palamidi Fortress. DAY 5 CRUISE TO SPETSES & HYDRA

Set sail through the legendary Greek Islands on a private cruise to beautiful, off-the-beaten-path Spetses. Enjoy an elegant, seaside lunch before a carriage ride to the picture-perfect Old Port of Spetses. Then, stop for a swim in a hidden cove off an uninhabited island. Arriving to unforgettable Hydra, check in to our traditional hotel and enjoy a festive dinner harborside as we settle into the slow pace of life on this charming island. (B,L,D)

Terms and Conditions

Price: \$6,195 per participant in double room occupancy (+\$1,550 as a single); Santorini Extension \$3,750 per person in double room occupancy (+\$1,800 as a single). International airfare is in addition to this price.

Included in price: Shared double room accommodations in four and five star accommodations; meals as indicated in the itinerary, including house wine with dinner; transportation and entrance fees to all sights, museums, and activities as indicated on the itinerary; airport-hotel transfers for travelers taking Sofia Travel arranged group flights; daily accompaniment and on-site instruction from Sofia Travel staff; hotel portorage for one suitcase; all taxes, fees, and gratuities.

Not Included in Price: International flights and all associated costs; airport transfers for travelers making their own air arrangements; single room supplements; meals not listed in the itinerary; optional activities; additions and changes to the listed program; travel insurance; excess baggage; individual transfers; internet or telephone fees at hotels; laundry; additional drinks, snacks, special meal requests and items of a personal nature.

Activity Level: Travelers should be able to enjoy walking unassisted for an extended period of time without resting, be sure-footed on uneven surfaces, enter and exit a moored boat, and walk up and down inclines and multiple flights of stairs easily and without assistance. Due to its unique position on the rim of an ancient volcano, the hotel in Santorini includes multiple flights of stairs between the hotel entrance, the rooms, and the breakfast area. Travelers are responsible for carrying their own carry-on luggage at all times.

Reservation and Deposit: A non-refundable, non-transferable deposit of \$800 per tour and \$1,200 per extension is required at the time of reservation to guarantee a place on the tour. The full balance is due December 5, 2025.

Luggage: Limit of one suitcase and one carry-on per person. Travelers are solely responsible for complying with all airline baggage weight and size limits. Hotel portorage is included for one suitcase per person. Carry-on luggage will be the responsibility of passengers at all times. Flights to and from Santorini for the Santorini extension are subject to the airline baggage weight and size limits and include one piece of checked luggage per person with a maximum of 23 kg (50 lbs).

Flights: Flights arranged by Sofia Travel are subject solely to the policies of the respective airlines, and seating arrangements cannot always be guaranteed until time of check-in. Sofia Travel is not responsible for any expenses incurred due to flight cancellations or changes. Travelers making their own flights may need to pay for airport-hotel transfers if arrival and departure times do not match group flight times.

Cancellation Fees: Sofia Travel must receive all cancellation and refund requests in writing. Registration and extension deposits are non-refundable and non-transferable. Cancellations received on or after December 6, 2025 will carry a 50% cancellation penalty, cancellations received on or after March 14, 2026 will carry a 75% cancellation penalty. No refunds will be given on or after April 25, 2026. All cancellation fees are based on the total tour price including all flights, extensions, and additional costs.

Insurance: Travelers are highly recommended to purchase travel insurance. Information will be sent with your Texas Exes confirmation. Travelers are fully responsible for understanding and agreeing to all stated terms and conditions of any third party insurance policy they may choose to purchase and absolve Sofia Travel of any responsibilities, payments, or refunds regarding travel insurance.

Documentation: U.S. citizens require a valid passport. The traveler assumes complete and full responsibility for, and hereby releases Sofia Travel from, any duty of checking and verifying any and all passport, visa, vaccination, health screening, or other entry requirements for each destination, and all safety and security conditions during the proposed travel. Please note that customs agents often require passport validity for six months from the return date of travel. Assuring passport validity for travel is the sole responsibility of the individual traveler.

Statement of Responsibility: Sofia Travel (ST) or the Texas Exes (TE) shall not be held responsible for any wrongful or negligent acts or omissions or defaults by any supplier or other party not directly owned or controlled by ST/TE or by the failure of any equipment operated by any such supplier or other party. ST/TE shall not be liable for any loss, injury, or damage to person, property or otherwise, in connection with any accommodations, transportation, or other services, resulting directly or indirectly from any acts of God, dangers incident to the sea, fire, breakdown of machinery or equipment, acts of government of other authorities, wars whether or not declared, hostilities, civil disturbances, strikes, riots, thefts, pilferages, epidemics, pandemics, quarantines, medical or customs regulations, defaults, delays or cancellations of or changes to itineraries or schedules. ST/TE is released from any and all claims and causes of action that a tour participant may hold for personal injury, property damage or wrongful death, arising out of participation in tour activities. ST/TE does not have special knowledge regarding the hazards of medical procedures in any location, suitability of medical travel for any person, financial condition of any supplier, unsafe conditions, health hazards, weather hazards, political conditions, or climate extremes at locations to which you may travel. ST/TE responsibility to passengers carried in vehicles and aircraft for transfer and excursions and tours is governed by the laws of the respective countries in which the tours take place and no other country. All claims against ST/TE must be made within 30 days of travel and are subject only to the jurisdiction of the courts of the country in which the cause of action arises. The right is reserved to substitute hotels and to alter itineraries. Individual or group cancellations due to factors outside of ST's control will be subject to the listed cancellation fees. All tickets and vouchers issued for transportation and services are subject to the terms and conditions under which such transportation and services are provided to the participant by the owners or contractors. Venue for any disputes is Travis County, TX. This contract shall be governed by the laws of the State of Texas.
