A World of Discovery

AHI Connects | *Meet the People.* Gain insights about Basque life over dinner and conversation with San Sebastián residents.

Guggenheim Museum Bilbao. Take in Bilbao's top sites on a scenic tour. Then, view the impressive art collections of the Guggenheim Bilbao, an architectural icon.

Old Quarter of Vitoria-Gasteiz.

The administrative capital of Basque Country, Vitoria-Gasteiz features an old quarter near the Cathedral of Santa María lined with streets named after the medieval trade guilds that once thrived there.

On a guided walk, admire the Plaza de la Virgen Blanca, palatial Renaissance gems and other noteworthy buildings.

Royal Palace of Olite. Feel transported to the Middle Ages as you visit this fairy-tale castle, once the court of Charles III, King of Navarra, fortified with crenellated towers.

Medieval Olite. Olite's medieval grandeur and rich history comes alive as you stroll with your guide along winding lanes to appreciate its architectural treasures.

Laguardia. Soak up the delightful ambience of the capital of Spain's Rioja Alavesa wine region on a guided walk. See the medieval fortifications, the Romanesque church, the Plaza Mayor and the underground tunnels.

Eclipse Viewing. Feel the soul-stirring impact of this unparalleled phenomenon firsthand. Watch in amazement as the moon gradually passes between the sun and Earth until the astounding period of totality, when it completely blocks the sun's rays.

Pamplona. Follow your guide along the atmospheric streets where crowds throng for the Running of the Bulls each July during the festival of San Fermín. See the Gothic Pamplona Cathedral, the bullfighting ring and lively Castle Square in the old town. Savor lunch at a winery after your visit.

San Sebastián. This sophisticated resort town dazzles with gorgeous beaches and a stellar culinary reputation. On a guided old town walk, see its highlights including the baroque Basílica de Santa María del Coro, and meander on the waterfront promenade.

Saint-Jean-de-Luz. Centuries ago, fishermen in this pretty French Basque beachfront town traded their nets for swords and cannons to become feared pirates. Delve into its swashbuckling past and more on a guided walking tour.
