Depart home city.

Day 2 | October 11 R-D

Milan, Italy | Como

Arrive in Milan and transfer to Como, the perfect "home" for our soggiorno in the spectacular mountainous Italian countryside. Check into the charming *Palace Hotel* on the shore of Lake Como and settle in. This evening, join your traveling companions for a Welcome Reception and Dinner at the hotel.

Day 3 | October 12 B-D

Start your morning by listening to a fascinating lecture about Como's history. On a guided walking tour, stroll through Old Como and admire magnificent architectural sites such as the Gothic Duomo di Como, the fresco-adorned Romanesque Basilica di San Fedele, the 13th-century town hall Broletto and the 12th-century gate tower Porta Vittoria. Tonight enjoy dinner on your own.

Day 5 | October 14 B

Como | Stresa for Borromean Islands

Enjoy a private boat transfer on Lake Maggiore, sailing past islands with beautiful villas, graced with natural beauty. Visit the crown jewel of the Borromean archipelago, Isola Bella, boasting the 17th-century Palazzo Borromeo. Explore the





baroque palace with its astounding collection of art and antiques, and the summerhouse, which is home to a mosaic marine-themed grotto. Stroll the lush gardens, filled with rare flowers and plants, statuary, architectural details and strutting white peacocks. Reboard the boat for the return to Stresa, the setting for Hemingway's iconic novel "A Farewell to Arms." Enjoy spectacular mountain views as you explore the town and have lunch on your own. This afternoon at the hotel, hear a lecture by a local expert on the silk industry, then enjoy dinner on your own.

Day 6 | October 15

Como

Today, delve deeper into Como during your choice of one of the following activities: pasta fresca cooking class, Como culinary tour, wine tasting at La Costa Winery or Como silk tour. Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure, and make your own plans for lunch and dinner.

Day 7 | October 16

Como | Bellagio

After a delicious breakfast buffet at the hotel, cruise by private boat across the sparkling waters of Lake Como, Italy's deepest and perhaps most spectacular lake, while learning about its fascinating history and allure. Visit the magnificent Villa del Balbianello, which you may recognize from "Casino Royale" and other films. Unique terraced gardens surround the villa, where holm oaks — evergreens native to the Mediterranean — are pruned into a distinctive umbrella shape.

Continue to the celebrated town of Bellagio. Often thought of as the most beautiful town in Italy, Bellagio flaunts a promenade lined with lime trees and oleanders, a city center of cobblestone streets and picturesque alleyways, and charming buildings painted in shades of cream, peach and
