Santiago

Days 1 & 2 | In Transit | Santiago, Chile

Depart your gateway city for Santiago, Chile. ✈️ Arrive, transfer 🚗 and check in to the hotel, ideally situated in the heart of Santiago.

Enrichment: *Chilean History.*

Welcome Reception & Dinner. Gather for tonight's festive kick-off reception and dinner.

Day 3 | Santiago

Santiago Highlights. Explore this capital city on a panoramic tour, with some stops. Pass by the Palacio de la Moneda and the palm-lined Plaza de Armas, flanked by historic buildings. Pause for a guided walk through the bohemian Bellavista neighborhood and Dardignac Street, brimming with vibrant street art and whimsical sculptures. Glimpse the former home of Nobel laureate Pablo Neruda. Pop in for a brief visit to a Chilean crafts store and then enjoy a tour of the Chilean Museum of Pre-Colombian Art.

Chilean Winery. Journey to the Maipo Valley for a tour of a traditional Chilean winery and its vineyards, with a tasting of reserve varietals.

Enrichment: *Contemporary Chile.*

Day 4 | Puerto Montt | Puerto Varas

Check out of the hotel and fly to Puerto Montt.

🌐 **AHI Connects | Curanto Lunch.** Head to a small fishing village for a traditional Chiloé lunch. Savor seafood, meats and vegetables cooked over red-hot stones in a shallow pit.

Transfer to Puerto Varas, check in to the hotel and join a short orientation walk around town.

Relax over dinner together at the hotel tonight.

Day 5 | Puerto Varas | Chiloé Island

Chiloé Island. Take a ferry to this picturesque island and begin with a walk through the town square with its graceful wooden church. Next, travel to Puñihuil and take a boat ride to marvel at Humboldt and Magellanic penguins close to their natural habitats. Return to Ancud for lunch and then visit The Museum of the Churches of Chiloé, which showcases miniature replicas of the island's 17th-century wooden churches.

Free Time: Enjoy a short stroll around Ancud.

Day 6 | Puerto Varas | Lakes Region

Petrohué Falls & Lake Todos los Santos.

Admire breathtaking scenery on a drive through Chile's beautiful, captivating Lakes Region.

Head to Petrohué to behold the jaw-dropping natural spectacle of its eponymous, turquoise river falls. Then, take a cruise on the emerald waters of Lake Todos los Santos, framed by dramatic, snowcapped volcano peaks.

Ensenada Village. Indulge in a Patagonian barbecue of traditional Chilean specialties.

Free Time: Explore Puerto Varas at leisure.

Enrichment: *The History of Patagonia.*

Day 7 | Puerto Varas | Punta Arenas

Check out and transfer to the Puerto Montt airport for your flight to Punta Arenas.

Nao Victoria Museum. Delve into maritime history at this interactive floating museum. Step aboard a full-scale replica of Magellan's ship, the first to circumnavigate the globe.

Mirador Cerro de la Cruz. Ascend to this lofty,



beloved urban viewpoint for panoramic views of Punta Arenas and the Strait of Magellan.

Walk to a nearby restaurant for a group lunch.

Free Time: Stroll through the Muñoz Gamero Square, bustling with artisan stalls and street performers, and then check in to the hotel.

Day 8 | Punta Arenas | Puerto Natales

Check out and transfer to Puerto Natales via motor coach. Arrive and check in to the hotel.

Free Time: Settle in, relax and relish some time at leisure in charming Puerto Natales.

Tonight, rejoin your group for dinner together.

Day 9 | Puerto Natales | Bernardo O'Higgins National Park

Fjord Cruise & Glaciers. Navigate through the steep-walled inlets of the awe-inspiring Última Esperanza Fjord. Marvel at emerald hillsides, rugged mountains, Patagonian birds and the awe-inspiring hanging Balmaceda Glacier.

Step ashore in the park and walk/hike along a trail through forests and open meadows. View

the spectacular Serrano Glacier, a jagged wall of blue ice towering above a milky lagoon.

Stop at a local Patagonian ranch for lunch and then cruise back to Puerto Natales.

Day 10 | Torres del Paine National Park

Panoramic Park Tour. Spectacular scenery awaits on a drive through the famed national park. Gaze at aquamarine lakes, rolling valleys and the visually arresting Horns of Paine mountain peaks. Pause at the Salto Grande waterfall to witness the raw power of turquoise waters thundering down into Lake Pehoé.

Stop in the park for lunch at Hotel Lago Grey.

Visit the park's Interpretation Center and return to Puerto Natales with photo stops en route.

Free Time: Relish time for dinner and a stroll.

Day 11 | Puerto Natales | Santiago

Take a flight from the Puerto Natales airport to Santiago. Transfer to the hotel for check-in.

Torres del Paine National Park

This sublimely beautiful national park spans 935 square miles at Chile's southern tip. Established in 1959, Torres del Paine unfolds in a dramatic panorama of turquoise lakes, majestic glaciers, sweeping valleys and snowcapped summits. The park's crowning jewels are the Cuernos del Paine, or Horns of Paine; the craggy trio of steel-gray Towers of Paine peaks; and the awe-inspiring Salto Grande waterfall. Deepening the park's allure is an abundance of wildlife, with approximately 25 species of mammals inhabiting the reserve: gray and red foxes; the guanaco, a close relative of the llama; the puma, the largest and most elusive; and the endangered Patagonian huemul deer. Flightless ostrich-like Lesser Rheas sprint across the grasslands propelled by their broad wings, and Andean condors circle the skies above.
