Each day promises immersive adventure: Hike through wildflower-dotted valleys and along trails leading to dramatic waterfalls, raft a glacial river in the shadow of volcanic peaks or Zodiac cruise past blue-tinged icebergs in the serene silence of an East Greenland fjord. Keep your eyes peeled for humpback whales, seals and—if luck is on our side—even the elusive polar bear.

Throughout the expedition, you'll be accompanied by a veteran team of naturalists, cultural specialists and a National Geographic Photographer, all dedicated to deepening your understanding and appreciation of these extraordinary environments. Their expert insights, combined with meaningful encounters ashore, deepen our understanding of the people who call these remote regions home.

This expedition is ideal for those who seek something different: not just spectacular scenery, but true exploration. And with Reykjavik just a few hours from the east coast of the U.S., this Arctic adventure is more accessible than you might imagine.

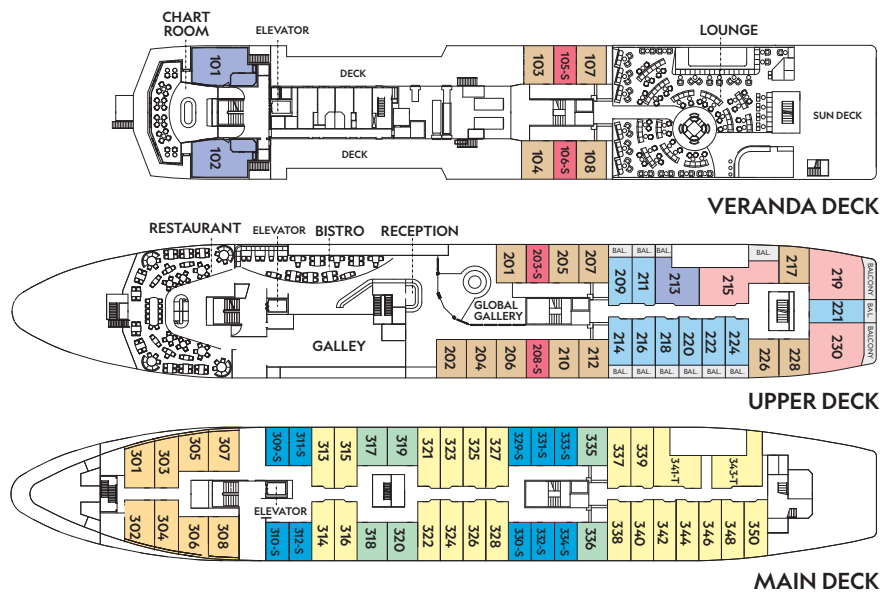
- Discover the rich biodiversity of the remote Westfjords, spotting nesting puffins along the coast and watching for humpback and minke whales in the surrounding waters.
- Navigate the icy coast of East Greenland while keeping a watchful eye for multiple species of whales and seals and the elusive polar bear.
- Take a challenging hike on an island plateau or a thrilling whitewater rafting trip in Skagafjörður, known as the cradle of Icelandic horsemanship and for its stunning geologic formations.
- Kids and teens will delve deeper into the region’s natural wonders with National Geographic Explorers-in-Training, an exclusive hands-on family program.



National Geographic Explorer

National Geographic Explorer accommodates 148 guests in 81 cabins. A purpose-built expedition ship, she is a fully stabilized, ice-class vessel with an ice-reinforced hull, enabling her to navigate polar passages while providing comfort, elegance and a deep connection to the environment. The ship is devoted to exploration—from her open Bridge and the chart room below it, to her high-perched observation deck, with its aqueous light and compelling views.
