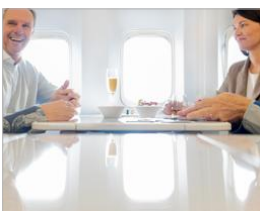

Day 1: En Route from U.S. Full travel day from U.S.

Day 2: Arrive in London, England (R,D)

Upon arrival to London's Heathrow Airport an Orbridge representative will be waiting to assist with your transfer to the hotel. The afternoon is yours to enjoy at leisure followed by a special welcome reception and dinner this evening.

Overnight: Rosewood London

Day 3: London • Fly to Marrakesh, Morocco (B,L,D)

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before transferring to an exclusive terminal at London Stansted Airport to board your privately chartered jet.

After take-off share a celebratory welcome toast and become acquainted with the dedicated crew. Get settled in your lie-flat leather seat and plug into in-flight entertainment and convenient charging stations. Pillows and amenity kits are available for additional comfort.

Lunch will be served during this relaxing, approximately 3.25-hour flight. In-flight meals are served directly to your seat with fine china and cutlery and include a selection of beverages.

After arriving venture to Jemaa el-Fna, a bustling marketplace in the main square of Marrakesh. This UNESCO World Heritage Site has been a cultural hub and artisanal gathering spot for centuries. Stroll by the countless vendor booths offering vast goods, services and entertainment from traditional medicine, fruit and food to fortune-telling, henna tattooing and snake charming.

After a café stop for refreshments continue to your five-star hotel to refresh and unpack before rejoining the group for a special dinner this evening.

Overnight: La Mamounia

Day 4: Marrakesh (B,L)

After breakfast join a local guide for an immersive city tour.

Return to the square for an inside visit of Koutoubia, Marrakesh's largest mosque and most famous landmark. Five times each day a call to prayer is heralded by a muezzin from atop the 250-foot-high minaret.

Continue to the Ben Youssef Madrasa, once the largest Islamic college in North Africa. Founded in the 14th century, this architectural masterpiece has been an intellectual hub for students seeking to deepen their knowledge in religious sciences, philosophy, medicine and mathematics. Admire the intricately carved cedar doors and ceilings, calligraphic plasterwork adorning the walls, and meticulously designed Zellige tile on the floors, fountains and columns.

Next see UNESCO-listed Palais Bahia. Constructed in the late 19th century, the palace was designed to be the grandest of its time with vast gardens, courtyards and lavishly decorated salons. Gain insight into Morocco's royal life during a lovely lunch on the rooftop terrace.

Return to the property to enjoy the remainder of the evening and dinner at leisure.

Overnight: La Mamounia

Day 5: Marrakesh • Fly to Walvis Bay,

Namibia • Swakopmund (B,L,D)

After breakfast return to your private jet for the approximate 8-hour flight to Namibia. Sit back, relax and take advantage of the well-appointed onboard facilities. Enjoy a nap, get lost in a book or mingle with fellow travelers at the stand-up bar and lounge.

Upon arrival to Walvis Bay International Airport transfer to a motor coach for the short ride to Swakopmund, our gateway to Sossusvlei. Check into the hotel with time to refresh before rejoining the group for dinner.

Overnight: Strand Hotel Swakopmund

Day 6: Swakopmund • Fly to Sossusvlei (B,L,D)

After breakfast meet with a local guide to explore Swakopmund, a coastal town known for its striking blend of German colonial architecture and African atmosphere.

Arrive at an airstrip to embark on a scenic flight to Sossusvlei. This sweeping aerial perspective of Namibia's dramatic landscapes provides an excellent vantage point for photography opportunities.

Continue to your five-star accommodations to check in, unpack and gather for a group dinner.

Overnight: Sossusvlei Lodge

Day 7: Sossusvlei • Namib-Naukluft National Park (B,L,D)

Enjoy a full day exploring Namib-Naukluft National Park, home to vast gravel plains and some of the tallest sand dunes on Earth. Within Sossusvlei lies Deadvlei, a white clay pan dotted with the blackened skeletons of ancient camel thorn trees, preserved for centuries by the arid climate.

Overnight: Sossusvlei Lodge

Day 8: Sossusvlei • Swakopmund • Walvis Bay • Fly to Cape Town, South Africa (B,L,D)

Have a leisurely breakfast before boarding the scenic charter flight back to Swakopmund. Board a bus to return to Walvis Bay International Airport for the approximate 1.75-hour flight to Cape Town aboard your private jet.

Check into your iconic pink hotel with time to refresh before gathering for a private welcome dinner. This landmark property has been providing exceptional hospitality since 1899.

Overnight: Mount Nelson Hotel by Belmond

Day 9: Cape Town (B,L)

This morning set out for Table Mountain, one of Africa's most iconic natural landmarks. Rising over 3,500 feet above Cape Town, its summit reveals panoramic views of the city, coastline and surrounding peaks, along with a unique ecosystem found nowhere else on Earth.



Following lunch at the V&A Waterfront you may choose to join one of the following optional activities (*no additional fees apply*) or explore independently.

Robben Island: Join a local guide for a private tour of this UNESCO World Heritage Site, where Nelson Mandela was held prisoner for 18 years.

Cape Peninsula and Boulders Beach: This activity includes guided touring plus entrance to a Table Mountain National Park protected beach area to observe a colony of critically endangered African Penguins in their natural habitat, waddling along the sandy shores and frolicking in the crystal-clear waters.

Constantia Winelands: Discover South Africa's oldest wine region nestled below the majestic Table Mountain National Park. Visit a wine estate for a tour and tasting featuring their popular varietals.

City Tour with Bo-Kaap and District 6: Also known as the Malay Quarter, Bo-Kaap is named for the Afrikaans phrase meaning "above the Cape." One of the oldest and most historic areas in Cape Town, it's synonymous with Islamic Cape Malay culture.

Delve into the region's rich and complex food heritage during a market visit to sample South African favorites such as samoosas, koesters, braai and hertzoggies.

Dinner will be at leisure this evening.

Overnight: Mount Nelson Hotel by Belmond



VICTORIA FALLS

Day 10: Cape Town • Fly to Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe (B,L,D)

Following breakfast return to your private jet for the approximate 2.5-hour flight to Victoria Falls. Transfer to your lodge, then set out for a steam train tour of the Victoria Falls Bridge. Learn about its construction, challenges faced by the engineers, and its role in regional trade and transport. Panoramic viewpoints provide dramatic photography opportunities.

Overnight: Victoria Falls Safari Lodge

Day 11: Victoria Falls (B,D)

Experience up close the roar of Victoria Falls, an impressive sight that transcends imagination. More than 300 feet high, the falls are one of the world's seven natural wonders and were named a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1989.

Following lunch on your own choose to join one of the following optional activities (*no additional fees apply*):

- Spa treatment package
- Helicopter flight over the falls
- Craft markets visit

Later rejoin the group to learn about tales and legends of the historic falls from a local historian and storyteller.

Afterward enjoy a special private dinner.

Overnight: Victoria Falls Safari Lodge

Day 12: Victoria Falls • Fly to Nosy Be, Madagascar (B,L,D)

Board your private jet for the approximate 3.25-hour flight to Nosy Be, a tropical island off Madagascar's northwest coast known for its volcanic lakes, ylang-ylang plantations and coral-fringed shores.

Another delightful lunch service will be provided en route.

Your first adventure is a visit to Lemuria Land. This protected nature reserve is home to several species of lemurs plus chameleons, crocodiles, tortoises and vast tropical botanicals.

During a guided tour discover Madagascar's endemic flora and fauna, and gain insight into the island's conservation efforts.

Continue to Mont Passot, an extinct volcanic peak and the highest point on Nosy Be. A short summit ascent provides amazing panoramic views overlooking a mosaic of crater lakes and the Mozambique Channel.

As sunset approaches, admire the colors reflecting off the island's volcanic basins.

This evening prepare for a delicious dinner featuring traditional Malagasy cuisine accompanied by local entertainment.

Day 13: Nosy Be • Lokobe National

Park (B,L,D)

This morning set off on a cruise to Ampasipohy, a fishing village considered the gateway to Lokobe National Park. Explore the pristine forest and spot for wildlife, then walk to the local village.

Climb into a traditional dugout canoe for a leisurely paddle around the coastline.

Continue to your accommodations for check-in. Afterward gather for a lecture by a prominent Malagasy primatologist to learn about the fascinating lemur species.

Overnight: Ravintsara Wellness Hotel

Day 14: Nosy Be • Fly to Nairobi,

Kenya (B,L,D)

After breakfast board a motor coach to transfer to a boat launch. Board your vessel and cruise to Nosy Komba—a small island just off the northwest coast of Madagascar.

Covered with dense tropical vegetation, the island's rich biodiversity is a haven for lemurs.

In the afternoon take the 2.5-hour flight to Nairobi—lunch will be served while in flight. Transfer to a local plane for the brief flight into the Maasai Mara National Reserve, a northern extension of the Serengeti ecosystem and one of the world's most rewarding wildlife observation sites.

Check in and meet with your local guides for a preview of tomorrow's exciting safari adventures.

Overnight: Angama Mara

Day 15: Maasai Mara (B,L,D)

Depart early this morning for a once-in-a-lifetime experience—a sunrise safari by hot air balloon over the Maasai Mara. Soar above the reserve at dawn for an exclusive bird's-eye view of wildlife roaming the expansive landscape.

Enjoy breakfast in the bush before boarding 4x4 safari Jeeps for a thrilling game drive through the reserve.

Expert guides well-versed in the behaviors of the wildlife provide informative commentary on the ecology, conservation efforts and fascinating facts about the diverse species inhabiting the reserve.

Overnight: Angama Mara

Day 16: Maasai Mara (B,L,D)

Today offers both morning and afternoon game drive opportunities to spot for The Big Five.

Mid-day, visit a traditional boma and gain insight into the rich culture of the Maasai people. Hear about their vibrant traditions and how they coexist harmoniously with the wildlife.

This evening gather together for a delicious barbecue feast.

Overnight: Angama Mara

Day 17: Maasai Mara • Fly to Giza, Egypt • Cairo (B,L,D)

Enjoy a scenic drive and final photography opportunities in the reserve before flying back to Nairobi's Jomo Kenyatta International Airport.

Transfer to your private jet for the 4.5-hour flight to Giza's Sphinx International Airport, a semi-private, less crowded facility providing a smooth arrival into Egypt. Lunch will be served in flight.

Overnight: Marriott Mena House, Cairo

Day 18: Cairo (B,L,R,D)

Today tour the Grand Egyptian Museum, an impressive complex described as the largest archaeological museum in the world and host to more than 100,000 artifacts.



GRAND EGYPTIAN MUSEUM ARTIFACTS

Peruse the extensive exhibits of royal tombs, portraits and prehistoric relics, and view the complete collection of King Tut's treasures, on display for the first time since first discovered in 1922.

This afternoon features a special private tour of the Great Pyramids of Giza followed by cocktail reception and farewell dinner at an award-winning restaurant with breathtaking views of the pyramids.

Overnight: Marriott Mena House, Cairo

Day 19: Cairo • Fly to London, England (B,L)

Following breakfast and check-out return to the airport to board your private jet one final time for the approximate 5.25-hour flight to London.

Delight in lunch, convivial camaraderie and a traditional English afternoon tea service during the journey.

Transfer to your hotel and enjoy the remainder of the evening at leisure.

Overnight: Fairmont Windsor Park

Day 1: En Route from U.S. Full travel day from U.S.

Day 2: Arrive in London, England (R,D)

Upon arrival to London's Heathrow Airport an Orbridge representative will be waiting to assist with your transfer to the hotel. The afternoon is yours to enjoy at leisure followed by a special welcome reception and dinner this evening.

Overnight: Brown's Hotel

Day 3: Stonehenge • Avebury (B,L)

Set out on a scenic two-hour journey through England's countryside to discover one of the world's most iconic and mysterious archaeological sites—Stonehenge.

During a guided tour around this UNESCO World Heritage Site, learn about speculations and theories surrounding the engineering of these Neolithic ruins. Stop at the impressive visitor center to view a variety of permanent exhibitions, which offer a glimpse into the unique nature of the Stonehenge site.

After a traditional English lunch at a local pub, survey the lesser-known site of Avebury. While Stonehenge is the most architecturally sophisticated prehistoric stone circle in the world, Avebury is the largest. Similar to other megalithic monuments in the British Isles, Avebury is a composite construction that was added to and altered during several periods.

Return to London where dinner and the remainder of the evening are at leisure.

Overnight: Brown's Hotel

Day 4: London • Fly to Cairo, Egypt (B,L,D)

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before transferring to an exclusive terminal at London Stansted Airport to board your privately chartered jet.

After take-off share a celebratory welcome toast and become acquainted with the dedicated crew.

Get settled in your lie-flat leather seat and plug into in-flight entertainment and convenient charging stations. Pillows and amenity kits are available for additional comfort. Lunch will be served during this relaxing, approximately five-hour flight. In-flight meals are served directly to your seat with fine china and cutlery and include a selection of beverages.

Upon arrival transfer to your five-star hotel to refresh and unpack before rejoining the group for dinner.

Overnight: Marriott Mena House, Cairo

Day 5: Giza (B,L,D)

Today visit the Grand Egyptian Museum, an impressive complex described as the largest archaeological museum in the world and host to more than 100,000 artifacts. Tour the extensive exhibits of royal tombs, portraits and prehistoric relics, and view the complete collection of King Tut's treasures, on display for the first time since first discovered in 1922.

Following lunch at the museum set out for a private visit to the pyramids of Giza, the only remaining Wonders of the Ancient World still standing. The Great Pyramid, 700 feet long on each side, is Egypt's largest and represents an astonishing structure completed more than 4,500 years ago. Approximately 2.3 million blocks of stone were cut, transported and assembled to create the 5.75-million-ton marvel. Its four sides are accurately oriented to the cardinal points of a compass.

Next see the Great Sphinx of Giza. This enigmatic stone carving—designed entirely from a single outcrop of limestone bedrock—depicts a lion's body with a man's face. The Sphinx faces the rising sun, and represents strength and wisdom.

This evening features a private dinner at a local restaurant with outstanding views of the pyramids.

Overnight: Marriott Mena House, Cairo



STONEHENGE

Day 6: Cairo • Fly to Aqaba, Jordan • Wadi Rum (B,L,D)

Following breakfast return to your private jet for the 60-minute flight to Aqaba, Jordan, on the Red Sea.

After lunch board a motor coach destined for Wadi Rum—nicknamed the “Valley of the Moon.” During a four-wheel drive excursion accompanied by local guides, discover Wadi Rum’s red sand dune landscape and massive rock formations. Stone Age petroglyphs and a continuing nomadic presence offer a rare window into humanity’s earliest beginnings.

Overnight: Mövenpick Resort Petra

Day 7: Petra (B,L,D)

This morning discover the ancient Nabataean caravan-city of Petra, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Spanning an impressive 100 square miles, this magnificent archaeological site has fascinated researchers and visitors since the early 19th century. During a guided tour explore elaborate tombs, monuments and religious high places. Along a wide path known as the Bab Al Siq observe the Obelisk Tomb, a structure that stands as a testament to the rich history and cultural heritage of the region. Step inside to discover a resting and dining hall with three benches once used for feasts to honor the dead. Stairs lead to burial halls with interesting light and shadows for photo opportunities.

Enjoy lunch and additional time to explore Petra independently or choose to return to the hotel for a restful afternoon.

This evening rejoin the group for dinner at the hotel.

Overnight: Mövenpick Resort Petra

Day 8: Aqaba • Fly to Delhi, India (B,L,D)

Early this morning return to your private jet to depart for the next exciting destination—Delhi, India.

During this approximately five-hour flight, sit back, relax and take advantage of the well-appointed onboard facilities. Enjoy a nap, get lost in a book or mingle with fellow travelers at the stand-up bar and lounge.

Lunch will be served on board. The jet will touch down in Delhi by early evening.

Upon arrival transfer to your five-star hotel. Take time to unpack then gather later for dinner.

Overnight: The Oberoi, New Delhi

Day 9: Old and New Delhi • Agra (B,L,D)

No journey of the world’s iconic destinations would be complete without time in the heart of colorful India.

India’s capital city, New Delhi, offers a captivating blend of old and new—an amalgam of tombs, temples and monuments existing side-by-side amidst modern suburbs and skyscrapers.



PETRA



Drive past the Red Fort—Delhi's most iconic monument and one of several UNESCO World Heritage Sites. Massive red sandstone walls standing 75-feet high enclose a complex of palaces, gardens and a mosque.

Across the road stands Jama Masjid, one of the finest examples of Mughal architecture in India. This mosque was built by Emperor Shah Jahan, who also commissioned the Taj Mahal.

Next experience renowned Chandni Chowk, Old Delhi's main thoroughfare and oldest market—a sensory delight teeming with a myriad of goods, colors, fragrances and flavors.

Continue to New Delhi, a grand city featuring wide boulevards, manicured formal parks and notable landmarks including Rashtrapati Bhavan, the official residence of the president and India Gate, a 138-foot-tall arch that bears the names of thousands of Indian soldiers who perished in conflicts such as World War I and the Third Afghan War. Admire the arched façade of Humayun's Tomb built in the mid-16th century. This regal mausoleum is considered the architectural forerunner of the Taj Mahal.

Following lunch at a local restaurant continue the journey to Agra situated beside the Yamuna River—home to the Taj Mahal and Agra Fort, both UNESCO World Heritage Sites.

Overnight: The Oberoi Amarvilas, Agra

Day 10: Agra (B,L,D)

Depart early for a sunrise visit of the Taj Mahal. Built between 1631 and 1648 by order of the Mughal emperor Shah Jahan in memory of his favorite wife, the Taj Mahal is an immense mausoleum of shimmering white marble that appears to change color depending on the light. This complex is one of the most outstanding examples of Mughal architecture, combining Indian, Persian and Islamic influences. Strolling the grounds, admire the calligraphy, minarets and intricate lattice screens adorning the structure.

Return to the hotel for breakfast before delving into Mughal history at Agra Fort. This colossal red sandstone fortress houses exquisite palaces, mosques and halls. Get a glimpse into the lifestyle of royalty and learn about the Mughal emperors who once resided here.

Following lunch at the hotel, relish in an afternoon at leisure with extended time to take advantage of the property's magnificent five-star amenities.

For those interested, there will be another opportunity to visit the Taj Mahal this evening to capture a magical sunset.

Afterward rejoin the group at a local restaurant for dinner.

Overnight: The Oberoi Amarvilas, Agra



AMER FORT

Day 11: Agra • Jaipur (B,L,D)

After breakfast and check-out, board your motor coach for the ride to Jaipur.

Known as the Pink City, this UNESCO World Heritage Site was carefully planned and arranged in a grid pattern of eight units around a central square. Its historic buildings were painted terracotta pink—a symbolic color of hospitality in honor of a visit by Prince Albert in 1876. A law passed in 1877 declared that any new buildings constructed must also bear this particular color.

Settle into your award-winning five-star hotel with time to refresh before rejoining the group for an informative lecture from a guest speaker.

Overnight: The Oberoi Rajvillas, Jaipur

Day 12: Jaipur (B,L,D)

During a panoramic city tour see the iconic Amer Fort (or Amber Fort), one of India's most well-known and frequently visited sites. Massive ramparts, successive gates and a zig-zagging cobblestone path leading up a hillside reveal four courtyards, palaces, halls and gardens.

Continue to City Palace—an impressive collection of courtyards, gardens and buildings. See structures from different eras, some dating from the early 20th century. It's a striking blend of Rajasthani and Mughal architecture, with surfaces adorned by carvings, silverwork and opulent textiles.

Adjacent to City Palace's entrance is Jantar Mantar observatory, constructed by Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh II between 1724 and 1730. Singh's passion for astronomy was even greater than his prowess as a warrior. Before construction began Singh sent scholars abroad to study foreign examples of such structures.

Jantar Mantar is the largest and the best-preserved of Singh's observatories. See what has captivated the attention of architects and art historians worldwide at this site packed full of interesting instruments.

Return to the hotel for lunch and an afternoon at leisure or choose to join one of the following optional activities (*no additional fees apply*).

Interactive Cooking Class: Join a local family as they share the secrets of crafting authentic Indian cuisine, guiding you through recipes during a hands-on experience to create a complete meal. Then be seated with your hosts to dine on the delectable dishes, accompanied by laughter, stories and refreshing drinks. *NOTE: This activity is in lieu of the scheduled lunch on the itinerary.*

Block Printing and Batik Workshop: Embark on a journey into the heart of the region's rich heritage and intricate block printing techniques. Learn from skilled artisans, explore the workshop and create your own unique printed textiles. All necessary materials plus refreshments are included. *NOTE: This activity is weather dependent.*

Blue Pottery and Miniature Painting Workshop: Meet Mrs. Meenakshi Singh, wife of the late Mr. Kripal Singh Ji, a renowned master of Jaipur Blue Pottery. She continues his legacy through exclusive, hands-on workshops teaching his masterful techniques.

This evening celebrate your time spent in India with a special themed dinner.

Overnight: The Oberoi Rajvillas, Jaipur

Day 13: Jaipur • Fly to Siem Reap, Cambodia (B,L,D)

Return to the airport to board your private jet for the journey across southern Asia to Siem Reap.

The approximately four-hour flight presents an opportunity to relax, recharge and reflect on recent sites and experiences with fellow travelers. Enjoy lunch and refreshments at your seat or in the company of others at the stand-up bar and lounge.

Upon arrival transfer to the hotel to unpack before dinner. Tomorrow's adventures begin at dawn.

Day 14: Angkor Wat (B,L,D)

Bodia Spa Treatment: Choose from a variety of treatments to pamper both body and soul using only natural Cambodian-made products.

Satcha Handicraft Center and APOPO Visitor Center: Visit six Cambodian arts and crafts workshops. Continue to APOPO, a global non-profit dedicated to training animals to detect landmines for safe removal.

Tonight's special dining experience is at Prasat Kravan.

Overnight: Sofitel Angkor Phokeethra

Day 15: Siem Reap (B,D)

Today's itinerary allows for a variety of touring options (*no additional fees apply*) or a full day of leisure to indulge in the hotel's luxurious amenities.

Jeep Safari: Join an expedition through Siem Reap's countryside, past rice paddy fields and local villages. Stopping in San-Day Village visit an organic vegetable farm providing the local ingredients for your lunch of traditional Khmer dishes.

Day 16: Siem Reap • Fly to Hanoi,

Vietnam (B,L,D)

Arriving at the bay, step aboard a private charter boat for a leisurely cruise through the tranquil waters. Enjoy lunch and dinner on board plus ample time to relax and take advantage of exceptional photography opportunities.

Overnight: Sofitel Legend Metropole Hanoi

Day 18: Hanoi • Fly to Muscat, Oman (B,L,D)

Day 20: Muscat • Fly to London, England (B,L)

Tour the Sultan Qaboos Grand Mosque. Imposing and glorious, this piece of modern Islamic architecture was a gift to the nation from Sultan Qaboos to mark his 30th year of reign. The mosque can accommodate 20,000 worshippers, including 750 women in a private *musalla* (prayer hall). See the beautiful main prayer hall and hand-loomed prayer carpet that took 600 women four years to weave.

After touring return to the airport to board your private jet one final time for the approximately eight-hour flight to London. Delight in lunch and a traditional English tea service during the journey.

Transfer to your hotel and enjoy the remainder of the evening at leisure.

Overnight: Fairmont Windsor Park

Day 21: London • Depart for U.S. (B)

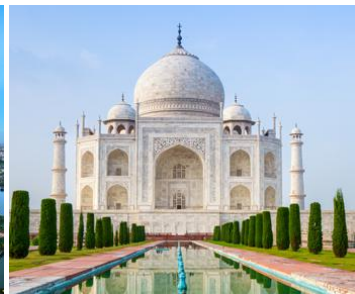
