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Itinerary

DAY ONE – ARRIVAL DAY

Check into Hotel Commonwealth, meet SET staff, and pick up on-site travel documents. In the early evening, enjoy a welcome reception, featuring dinner and a discussion titled *Baseball 101* with an expert in the sport.

DAY TWO

Following a private group breakfast, make the easy walk to Fenway Park for a private tour of one of baseball's most historic ballparks. Then the group will watch the Red Sox in action with the remainder of the day open to explore Boston at leisure.

DAY THREE

After a private group breakfast, take a scenic bus ride to Historic Cooperstown, including a brief stop in Stockbridge for lunch at the Red Lion Inn. After checking into the Otesaga Resort, kick back and relax before a group dinner along with a brief discussion on Cooperstown's significance to baseball and the Hall of Fame.

DAY FOUR

National Baseball Hall of Fame Day! Following breakfast, the group will be welcomed by Hall of Fame staff and taken for a private Artifact Spotlight for an up-close experience of historic baseball items. Afterwards, the group will tour the Hall of Fame. The afternoon and evening will be at leisure to explore all that Cooperstown has to offer.

DAY FIVE

Early this morning, set off on a scenic bus ride from Cooperstown to New York City. The day will feature a tour of Yankee Stadium, New York Yankees game, and tour farewell event to recap the week's events.

DAY SIX

Following breakfast, check out of the Refinery Hotel and have a safe trip home!

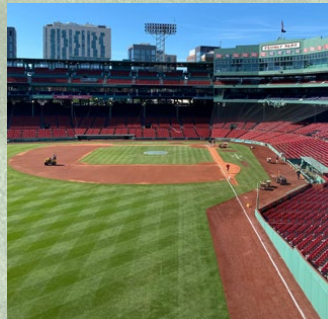
