Discovery

AHI Connects: Rock Ferry Winery. Enjoy a relaxing, casual lunch and tasting at this family-owned, organic winery that produces 15 varieties using grapes from two wine-growing regions.

City of Sails. See Auckland’s highlights on a scenic tour. Cross the iconic Harbour Bridge and visit Viaduct Harbour, Queen Street and Auckland Domain park. At the Auckland War Memorial Museum, view Maori *taonga*, or treasures, and see a traditional *haka*, the fierce Maori war dance. Stop in quaint Parnell afterward.

Safari of the Scenes. Explore the Queenstown-area locations that became Middle-earth in the “Lord of the Rings” movies. Follow a historic goldmining road and try panning for gold. Gaze at stunning vistas over Wakatipu Basin.

Doubtful Sound Tour. Marvel at Fiordland National Park’s awe-inspiring beauty on a full-day excursion. Cruise across Lake Manapouri’s shimmering waters, then travel over the Wilmot Pass and see the rain forest. Sail through the pristine stillness of Doubtful Sound, the deepest of New Zealand’s fiords, on a three-hour catamaran cruise. *(Active)*

Franz Josef Glacier. En route to the area, see splendid Lakes Dunstan, Hawea and Wanaka. Get a close-up view of one of the world’s fastest moving glaciers on a thrilling walk through the glacier valley. Later, visit a wildlife center to see endangered kiwi birds. *(Active)*

TranzAlpine Train Ride. Take this celebrated, picturesque train journey, from Greymouth to Christchurch, up through dense alpine forests and across the snowcapped Southern Alps. Travel next to the ice-fed Waimakariri River and cross golden farm fields on the plains.

Christchurch. Delight in a panoramic city tour and a Botanic Gardens visit.

Kaikoura. Spectacular wildlife-watching abounds near this coastal town known for its abundance of marine residents: whales (including giant sperm whales and orcas), furs seals and dusky dolphins. Encounter these amazing creatures, as well as albatross and other seabirds, on a whale-watching cruise.

Marlborough Wines. Sample the fine creations of picturesque Marlborough, the country’s largest winegrowing region, renowned worldwide for its Sauvignon Blanc and a range of delicious varieties. Visit two outstanding wineries for tastings.
